I, Assistant Chief Fire Officer Walmsley of Northern Ireland Fire & Rescue Service (NIFRS), hereby give you notice that NIFRS is of the opinion that the following use of the said premises in respect of which you are under an obligation to comply with The Fire and Rescue Services (Northern Ireland) Order 2006, namely

Type of premises, eg, hotel or shop Warehouse

involves, or will involve, a risk to persons on the premises in case of fire so serious that the use of the premises shall be prohibited.

NIFRS is further of the opinion that the matter(s) which give rise to the said risk are:

- No adequate means of detecting and raising the alarm in the case of fire.

and NIFRS hereby directs that the use of the premises to which the Notice relates is prohibited as follows:

Notwithstanding any consultation undertaken by NIFRS, **before** you make any alterations to the premises, **you** may need to apply for approval from either Building Control and/or any other bodies having a statutory interest in the premises.

The location and details of matters which are considered to be failures to comply with The Fire & Rescue Services (Northern Ireland) Order 2006 are detailed as follows:

- The fire detection system is inadequate contrary to Regulation 12(1)(a) and 12(2) of The Fire Safety Regulations (NI) 2010.

You should note that, where remedial action is required, it has been identified in general terms only. There will often be more than a single solution to a fire engineering problem and it remains the appropriate person's responsibility, on completion of a risk assessment, to provide adequate safety measures.
